

Vanderlyn Room Parents

Each classroom at Vanderlyn has two Room Parents that are randomly selected from volunteers by the teacher. One of the Room Parents is the “Key Contact” who is primarily responsible for communicating with the families in the classroom. The other Room Parent functions as the “Volunteer Coordinator” and makes sure that all volunteer roles are filled throughout the year.

As Room Parents you assist the Teacher in planning, recruiting and coordinating Volunteer opportunities in the classroom. You will meet with the teacher at the beginning of the year to plan the activities throughout the year that have parental volunteer opportunities.

The Key Contact will also be sent messages from the PTA via the Room Parent Coordinator to pass onto the families in their classroom.

Please remember that if you are not chosen as one of the 2 Room Parents that there will be many opportunities to volunteer throughout the year!
